School run clubs are allocated on a first come first served basis, if a club is full please email the school office to be added to the waiting list. Pupils can only select one school run club, if a club is full please email the school office to be added to the waiting list.

Booking session will open Monday 1st December at 6:00pm

Allocation of Places and Payment

Once the online booking session is closed a letter will be sent home with pupils confirming their place and outlining the club dates, times, any payment details and the collection gate. You must return the completed reply slip to the school office by the date stated on the letter or your child's place may be allocated to another pupil.

If you apply for any external clubs/TA clubs, they will contact you directly to confirm places, dates and payment details.

Club Attendance and Pick up Arrangements

All clubs will keep a register and your child will need to tell the teacher in charge if they have to miss the club for any reason. This is important for health and safety reasons and as a matter of courtesy. We will also need to know the collection arrangements and emergency contact details for your child for after school clubs. Children must be collected on time at the end of each club, repeated late collection or missed sessions will result in your child losing their space. If your child no longer wants to attend an allocated club, please let the school office know as the club can be offered to another child.
