Dear Year 4 Parents / Carers

Year 4 Trip to The Science Museum – Friday 6th February 2026

A booking has been made to take Year 4 on a trip to The Science Museum in Central London on Friday 6th February 2026.

The purpose of this trip is to view and investigate states of matter, sound and electricity as part of the Science Topic that the children learn during the Autumn and Spring terms. During our visit, the children will take part in a Wonder Show session and enjoy time exploring the Wonderlab.

We will be travelling to The Science Museum, via train and tube, taking advantage of TFL's free school party travel scheme.

Arrangements for the day

- We will be departing from school at 9.00am promptly, to catch the 9.30 train from Waddon to London Victoria, we will then travel to South Kensington by tube. We will require all children to be in school by 8.30am on this day for an early registration and to ensure they are fully equipped for the day.
- Children should wear PE Kits and a coat suitable for the weather on the day.
- All children will require a packed lunch for this trip. If your child normally has a school meal on this day, you can request a school provided packed lunch, using the packed lunch order from link below, this form needs to be completed by Friday 23rd January, so our catering providers can pre-order the ingredients.

If you will be providing your child with a packed lunch, it would be helpful if you still complete this form, as it helps the staff when preparing for the trip.

Lunches should be in a named carrier bag with disposable packaging as they will be disposed of at the museum and not brought back to school. Reminder that packed lunches should not include, fizzy drinks, sweets and as we are a nut free school, no items that may contain nuts, such as chocolate spread, peanut butter and cereal bars etc.

- No bags will be required, just packed lunches in a carrier bag that can be disposed of.
- **IMPORTANT** Due to our Wonder lab workshop booking taking place later in the afternoon, we will not be leaving the museum until 3pm and will be aiming to catch the 3.30pm train to Waddon, so our return to school will be after school finish time, arriving back at school at approximately 4.30pm. If there are any changes to this return time we will update parents via in touch messaging.

Cost

There is no cost to parents for this trip, due to using the TFL school party travel scheme for transport and Year 4's allocation from our school fund contributions, to cover the cost of museum workshops.
