Dear Parents and Carers,

This half term, the children will be exploring sculpture through fun and creative activities using card and recycled materials. They will learn how to turn flat (2D) shapes into three-dimensional (3D) forms by folding, curving and joining pieces together. They will experiment with different ways to make strong structures that can stand on their own and explore a range of joining techniques.

The children will also learn the difference between 2D and 3D art in simple terms and identify familiar shapes in photographs, including noticing shapes in the spaces between objects (negative space). They will draw their models from different angles, focusing on both the shapes they can see and the spaces around them to create abstract artwork.

As part of the project, children will plan and create their own abstract sculpture inspired by play equipment, thinking carefully about shape, structure and balance. They will be encouraged to try different ways of shaping materials (such as folding and rolling), choose suitable methods for joining, and reflect on how they can improve their work by adding details.
