### Year 4 Trip to – Unicorn Theatre – London – Friday 5th June 2026

The booking to take Year 4 on a trip to The Unicorn Theatre, Tooley Street, London, has now been confirmed.

We will be visiting the Unicorn Theatre to watch a performance of Planet Omar. The children have greatly enjoyed reading Planet Omar during their reading lessons, so this trip will be a wonderful opportunity to bring the story to life and further nurture their love of reading.

#### Arrangements for the day

- We will be departing from school at 9.00am promptly, to catch the 9.35 train from Waddon to London Bridge, it is then a short walk to the theatre. We will require all children to be in school by 8.30am on this day for an early registration and to ensure they are fully equipped for the day.
- Children should wear PE Kits and a coat suitable for the weather on the day.
- All children will require a packed lunch for this trip. If your child normally has a school meal on this day, you can request a school provided packed lunch, using the packed lunch order form - link below

If you will be providing your child with a packed lunch, it would be helpful if you still complete this form, as it assists the teacher to have a comprehensive list, when preparing for the trip. There is an option to say you will be providing your own packed lunch.

This form needs to be completed by Friday 21<sup>st</sup> May, so orders can be passed to our catering company before half term.

Lunches should be in a named carrier bag with disposable packaging as they will be disposed of at the museum and not brought back to school. Reminder that packed lunches should not include, fizzy drinks, sweets and as we are a nut free school, no items that may contain nuts, such as chocolate spread, peanut butter and cereal bars etc.

- No bags will be required, just packed lunches in a carrier bag.

We are expecting to return to school before the end of the school day, if there are any delays you will be notified by text.

If you have any queries regarding the day itself, please contact your child's class teacher.
