Dear Year 4 Parents/Carers,

As our residential trip is fast approaching, we thought we would send some more information about the running of the trip and a few reminders of what your child will need.

For the residential, your children will be accompanied by: **Miss Chowdhury, Miss Warren, Mrs Hills and Mrs Riches.**

Please find a reminder of the kit list below, but please remember when packing that the children will need to be able to carry their own belongings to the cabins - as teachers will have their own belongings to carry too.

**For outdoor activities:**

Jumpers, trousers, long sleeved t-shirt (to protect arms during activities) short sleeved t-shirts, shorts (for when not doing activities) and a warm hoodie for the evening	
Old pair of trainers + a change of shoes (flip-flops, crocs or open back/toe shoes are not suitable for activities)	
Warm coat (weather dependant)	
Waterproofs	
Hat and gloves/sun cream and sun hat (weather dependant)	
A named, reusable water bottle	
Plenty of underwear/socks	
Glasses strap/cord if you wear glasses	

No swimming kit is needed



**For the cabin:**

Towel and wash kit	
Slippers or thick socks to wear around the cabin as outdoor shoes are not allowed	
Pyjamas	
Any medication (to be handed to Miss Warren).	
Extra clothes for the following day(s)	

**Additional handy things to pack:**

Plastic bags/bin liners for dirty/muddy clothes	
A small soft toy that brings comfort	
Torch (optional)	
Clock (optional but advised)	

**Medical and Emergency Contact Information**

**NO mobile phones, electronic devices or snacks**

Please ensure that everything is named, as this makes packing and locating items whilst we are there run smoothly and ensures that all items are returned home with your child.

**Timings**

On Monday morning, drop off to school will be at normal time (8:35am – 8:50am) and the children will meet us in the hall having dropped all their belongings by the cabin. Please bring in any medicine or medical equipment to the office to be collected by our first aider, Miss Warren. Please label the medication with your child's name. Miss Warren will check the medication in 1 at a time, so please make sure that it is labelled in advance to speed this process up. If your child requires travel sickness tablets, then please also bring this to the office. If they can take it beforehand, then please give it to them.



### **Monday 6th July 2026**

The coach is aiming to set off at approximately 9:30am. All children will need a disposable packed lunch for Monday – the kitchen will NOT be able to provide it for you. The coach will then be dropping us off on our first adventure where we will complete a lovely woodland walk to the venue that will take about 40 minutes. A minibus will carry all of the luggage to the site. They may need to carry/pull their luggage for a short distance, so please ensure they are able to carry/pull it. Your child will need to bring a rucksack with water, nut free packed lunch, sunscreen and hat. They will carry this rucksack during the woodland walk. Please also ensure the children are dressed appropriately for the woodland walk where their legs and feet are covered. Trainers are also advised.

### **Wednesday 8th July 2026**

After our fun filled day (which we are sure you will hear lots about!) we will be having lunch at the venue then getting the coach back to school at approximately 2:00pm. We should arrive back to school for the normal end of the day but will keep the office staff informed of our journey time in case of any delays. Please make sure you check the information sent to you before arriving at school. We are really looking forward to our few days of adventure and hope you are too!

### **Additional information**

On one of the evenings, we will be providing the children with hot chocolate, biscuits and marshmallows (gelatine free for Halal). Please speak to Miss Chowdhury or Miss Warren or email if you have any concerns about this.

We understand that it is difficult to name every item of clothing, however, please can you ensure any item of clothing that may be taken off during the day due to change in weather is named (e.g. hoodies, cardigans, jumpers, coats and shoes).

The children will also be making their own beds! If you could get time to practise putting on a duvet cover on a duvet and a sheet on a bed, that would be wonderful! Thank you!
