Dear Year 6 Parents and Carers,

This half-term, Year 6 will be studying the RE unit "*Why Is There Suffering in the World?*" and exploring Christian beliefs about creation, free will, suffering, prayer, and Jesus' teachings. A copy of the Bible will support their learning at this time.

This year marks the 500th anniversary of the work associated with William Tyndale and the translation of the Bible into English. To commemorate this milestone, The Trinitarian Bible Society has published a special edition of the Authorised (King James) Version of the Bible.

We are pleased to offer Year 6 pupils the opportunity to receive a free copy of this commemorative Bible. This special edition features a pictorial cover showing the statue of William Tyndale on Victoria Embankment in London and includes special presentation and introductory pages, as well as a historical timeline outlining the story of the Bible in English.

State schools, such as High View, practise collective worship, which is broadly in line with Christian values and forms part of the wider spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of our pupils. This commemorative Bible is offered as an optional resource that some families may find meaningful as pupils approach the end of their primary school years.
