### **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2026 – Heritage Mufti (Year 6 only)**

Due to secondary transition days, Year 6 will be having their Heritage Mufti day on Monday and not Wednesday. Children will not be required to bring in cultural foods to share with their class mates on the day

### **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July – Heritage Mufti and Class Party**

This will be a whole school mufti day, where children are invited to wear traditional clothing that represents their cultural heritage. **Please note:**

- Children who normally have PE on this day do not need to wear their PE kit.

We encourage children to bring in cultural foods to share with their class during the afternoon class party.

**To ensure everyone's safety:**

- We are a nut-free school – no food containing nuts or traces of nuts is permitted.

All food items must include a full list of ingredients.

Due to limited refrigerated storage, please ensure food items are non-perishable.

All food should be brought in a named container and handed to the class teacher in the morning.

In addition to food, children are also welcome to bring in:

- Photos, musical instruments, or other cultural items to share with their class.

**Friday 3rd July - Colour Run!**

To conclude our Cultural Diversity Week, we are excited to be hosting a Colour Run for children in Years 1 to 6 at Sheen Way.

This vibrant and interactive event is designed to symbolise the rich diversity of global cultures, bringing our school community together in a fun and meaningful way. The Colour Run will also be a sponsored event, raising funds for our new school library. The PTFA will be sending out sponsorship information for the Colour Run. .

**Important information for the day:**

- Your child should come to school wearing a plain white T-shirt. These will be available for purchase on the playground after school in the week leading up to the event. Alternatively your child can wear their own old T-shirt.
- Children do not need to bring their school bags, only their labelled water bottle.
- If you would like to protect your child's hair they may wear a hat or a hair cover
- While the coloured powder used during the run is non-toxic, safe, and machine washable, we recommend that parents bring a towel at pickup to help remove some of the powder before children get into the car during collection.
- Children should be collected at the usual pickup time from the playground.

If you have any questions about the events taking place throughout the week please email your child's class teacher. There will be more information about this event nearer the time.
