High View Art Exhibition Competition

We are excited to announce that our High View Art Exhibition and Competition will take place on **Friday 19th June 2026, from 3:30pm to 4:30pm.**

This event is a superb opportunity for children from nursery to year 6 to showcase their creativity by exhibiting an art piece of their choice.

No theme. No restrictions. Any type of art is welcome — painting, sketching, photography, digital art, sculpture, mixed media and more! We want to see creativity, imagination and artistic talents exuding from every piece. Let their imagination run wild!

Pupils will pay £1 cash to enter and bring their entry into the hall (EYFS will be supported) with their name and class clearly labelled. To protect anonymity and help reduce bias, we will number each entry instead of names during judging.

If your child would like to take part, please note the following:

- They will be responsible for bringing in their art piece entry.
- The art piece entry must be brought to the hall in the morning.
- If your child would like to participate, please complete the [Google form](#), providing their name, year group, and a brief description of the art piece they are exhibiting/entering.

The form is to be completed by Wednesday 17th June at 6pm.

A paper copy of this form can be made available should you prefer.

Money raised will be split between The Sherwood Foundation (a local school for children with disabilities) and our school library which was decided during a School Council meeting.

Even if your child chooses not to participate, we warmly invite you to attend the Art Exhibition/ Competition and explore the pieces on display.

The School Council alongside Mr Taylor, Mrs Brajesh (Art Lead) and Miss Bernard will be judging the entries on Monday 22nd June. There will be an overall winner from each phase (EYFS, Key Stage 1 & Key Stage 2). Winners to be announced during our Celebration Assembly on Friday.



Judging will be based on four criteria:

- Creativity and Originality
- Effort and Presentation
- Skill and Technique
- Overall Impact and Impression

We look forward to seeing the creative flair our young artists showcase!
