Sport Days 2026

We will soon be holding our annual school sports days and we are delighted to be able to invite you all to join us again.

To help sports day to run smoothly, we kindly ask parents to refrain from calling or going over to their child during the event. This can cause a scramble effect and disrupt events. Please allow school staff to manage any situations that may arise. Our team are well prepared to support the children throughout the games.

Nursery – Wednesday 24th June (10:00 - 10:30am) at school:

- Children can wear their school uniform as this is suitable for sports day but they can come to school in shorts and PE trainers.
- All children **MUST** bring in a sun hat, water bottle and have sun cream applied before they come to school.
- Parents please enter the main school through the KS2 playground. Please come in through the car park and walk towards KS2 playground. We are unable to let any spectators enter or exit once the event has started.
- Parents are to stand along the fence facing the children.
- At the end of the sports days, parents will have an opportunity to say goodbye to their child and will then be asked to leave. Once all parents have left, the children will be able to return to class.
- Parents exit by walking back through the KS1 playground and out the car park gate.
- Parents of morning children are welcome to take their child home at the end of the sports day or can collect them at the normal time at the end of the morning session.

Reception - Tuesday 23rd June from 9:20 - 10:40am (at school):

- Children can wear their school uniform as this is suitable for sports day but they can come to school in shorts and PE trainers. Alternatively, children can wear their school PE kit.
- All children **MUST** bring in a sun hat, water bottle and have sun cream applied before they come to school.
- Parents please enter the main school KS2 playground. Please come in through the car park and walk towards KS2 playground. We are unable to let any spectators enter or exit once the event has started.
- Parents are to stand along the fence facing the children. Parents exit by walking back through the KS1 playground and out the car park gate.



Key Stage 1 - Friday 26th June from 9:30-11:30am (at Sheen Way)

Rehearsal – Friday 19th June - no spectators

- As the Key Stage 1 Sports Day is on the same day as the World Cup multi-day, children who wear mufti on this day must wear clothes and footwear which are suitable for the sports day.
- All children **MUST** bring in a sun hat, water bottle and have sun cream applied before they come to school.
- We will aim to leave school promptly in the morning so please ensure your child is in school on time.
- Parents can enter via the gate on Sheen Way from 9:15am. Please be considerate of residents when parking.
- Parents will be asked to stand on one side of the track with the children on the other side.
- Should time allow, there will be a parent race.
- **We will be having a practice event (without any spectators) on Friday 19th June. Please ensure your child comes to school on this day in their PE kit, even if it is not their usual PE day.**

Key Stage 2 – Thursday 25th June (at Sheen Way) from 9.30am to 12:15pm

Rehearsal – Monday 22nd June - no spectators

- Children are asked to come to school wearing their PE kit and suitable footwear
- All children **MUST** bring in a sun hat, water bottle and have sun cream applied before they come to school.
- We will aim to leave school promptly in the morning so please ensure your child is in school on time.
- Parents can enter via the gate on Sheen Way from 9:15am. Please be considerate of residents when parking.
- Parents will be asked to stand on one side of the track with the children on the other side.
- Should time allow, there will be a parent race.
- **We will be having a practice event (without any spectators) on Monday 22nd June. Please ensure your child comes to school on this day in their PE kit, even if it is not their usual PE day.**

In the event of adverse weather we may have to reschedule. We will notify parents if any of the above days are rescheduled.
