Thank you for your patience in finding out about next year's class teacher arrangements. We would like to inform you of the updated and final transition plan. Please look carefully at the key dates below:

Key Transition Dates - Updated

Date	Transition Event
Monday 22nd June 2026	All children, who will be in year 1 to 5 next year, will find out the name of their new class and new class teacher.
Monday 22nd June 2026	As well as class teachers, Reception and Year 4 children will also find out who will be in their class next year - as you know these two year groups are mixed into new classes. Please prepare your child for this day; it can be a little overwhelming for the children finding out their new teacher and new classmates. A class list of first names will be sent to families in Reception and Year 4. Please complete this form if you do not want your child's name to be published on a class list to be sent to all parents. This form will close on Monday 22nd June at 12pm.
Thursday 25th June 2026	2026 -2027 Nursery and Reception children will find out the name of their new class and new class teacher. This will be shared with parents in the evening welcome meetings for new entrants.
Friday 3rd July	Transition day 1 - Children meet their new teacher in their new classes
Monday 13th July 2026	Transition day 2 - Children go to their new classroom with their new teacher present
Monday 13th July 3:30pm-5:00pm	Open afternoon - parents are invited to meet their child's new class teacher

Drawing on feedback from parents in previous years, and while ensuring the school continues to operate effectively, we hope this transition process is giving families ample time and opportunity to help their children prepare for the changes ahead.
