High View School – Hot Weather Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the current hot weather warning and in line with our High View Hot Weather Plan, we are making some temporary adjustments to ensure the safety, wellbeing and comfort of all children during the exceptionally high temperatures expected this week.

Sports Days

With the exception of the Reception Sports Day, which will go ahead as planned, we have taken the decision to postpone all other Sports Days. The revised dates and times are as follows:

- **Nursery Sports Day (in school)** – Monday 29th June, 10:00am–10:30am
- **Key Stage 1 Sports Day (Sheen Way)** – Monday 6th July, 9:15am
- **Key Stage 2 Sports Day (Sheen Way)** – Tuesday 14th July, 9:15am

We appreciate your understanding and look forward to welcoming families to these rescheduled events.

Early Collection Option

Due to this week's hot weather warning, we are also offering all parents and carers the opportunity to collect their children early at **1:15pm on Wednesday and Thursday** from their usual collection point.

Children who are not collected by **1:25pm** will be taken back to their classrooms and will continue with the remainder of the school day as normal. We ask that parents do not collect children between 1:25pm and 3:20pm.

After school clubs will continue as usual but will remain indoors on Wednesday and Thursday. This may be the protocol for the rest of the week depending on the heat.

Year 5 and 6 Who go Home Alone

Please note that, if children in Y5/6 have permission to travel home independently, you still must give permission for your child to be released at the earlier time of 1:15pm if they are

not being collected. Please complete this form to give permission for your child to leave school at 1:15pm on Wednesday and Thursday.

Additional Measures

To help keep children safe and comfortable during the hot weather the school will be implementing the following additional measures:

- Regular cooling and water breaks throughout the day.
- Rotation of classes accessing air-conditioned rooms.
- On Wednesday and Thursday the children will not be playing outdoors during breaktimes or lunchtimes. This may be the case for the rest of the week, depending on the heat. We may make an exception for the early years as they have immediate access to the inside of the building and can choose to stay inside or out depending on the heat.
- Staff will closely monitor children for signs of heat-related discomfort and encourage regular hydration.

Uniform

For the remainder of this week, children may wear their PE kit to school, if they wish. This will help them stay cool and comfortable during the hot weather. In addition, children may choose to replace their PE top with a white polo top.

We kindly ask that children come to school with a named water bottle, pre-applied sunblock and an appropriate and named sun hat.

Thank you for your continued support and understanding as we prioritise the health and wellbeing of our staff and children.
