Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share an exciting potential opportunity for our children. We are currently in discussions with White Dog Music to offer high-quality, contemporary music tuition during the school day.

White Dog Music provides a modern approach to music education, led by professional musician and educator Simon White. The proposed offer includes:

- **Instrumental Lessons:** Guitar, bass guitar, piano/keyboard, drums, and singing.
- **Contemporary Choir:** A session for pupils to sing together.
- **Band Performance Sessions:** These act as a bolt-on to instrumental lessons, providing a platform for pupils to practise skills learned in lessons and demonstrate progress in a fun, supportive group environment.

As well as high quality lessons and broadening opportunities, another key benefit of this provision is convenience: all equipment and textbooks are provided for the lessons, so children do not need to bring anything to school - all equipment and resources will be kept at school. Lessons are 30 minutes long and are held during the school day.

Age Groups: For this initial roll-out, the sessions will be available as follows:

- **Contemporary Choir:** children from Reception (ages 5–6) onwards.
- **Instrumental Lessons:** children from Year 2 (ages 6–7) onwards.

Funding and Accessibility: At this stage, the tuition would be funded by parents. However, should the programme prove viable and successful, the school is committed to exploring future ways to make this music offer more universally accessible to our wider school community.

Pricing Structure The current pricing for these private lessons is as follows:

- **Individual Lesson:** £18 per lesson
- **Group of 2:** £12 per lesson
- **Group of 3:** £8 per lesson
- **Group of 4:** £7 per lesson
- **Group of 5:** £6 per lesson
- **Band or Choir Sessions:** £6 per session

Parents will be invoiced termly, ahead of the start of the first lesson. A term typically lasts for 10 to 12 weeks.
