Dear Parents / Carers,

'Beat the Beep' Gymnastics Fundraising

We are excited to announce a new whole-school PE fundraising event: **'Beat the Beep!'**, taking place on **Friday 2nd October** during the school day.

Every child in school will take part in this fun and active challenge, with the aim of raising money towards **new gymnastics equipment for our school**.

The children will take part in a bleep-test-style challenge on the school's AstroTurf. The challenge will become progressively more demanding from Early Years through to Year 6, with children competing against others in their year group.

The children will be encouraged to challenge themselves, demonstrate perseverance and support one another while raising money for new PE equipment.

We are asking for a voluntary donation via **School Gateway** for each pupil:

- **Early Years – 50p**
- **KS1 – £1**
- **KS2 – £2**

We are hoping to raise enough money to purchase new gymnastics springboards for the children to use during PE lessons.

Our fundraising targets are:

£350 = 1 gymnastics springboard

£700 = 2 gymnastics springboards

£1,050 = 3 gymnastics springboards

One springboard can be shared between approximately **10 pupils during a gymnastics lesson**, meaning that reaching our target will directly benefit many of our children.

In addition to the voluntary donation, we would love children to collect sponsorship from family and friends.

You can choose to sponsor your child with a **one-off donation** or **an amount for each lap they complete** during the challenge.

Every donation, no matter how small, will help us get closer to our target and provide the children with exciting new gymnastics equipment.

There will be some additional incentives to encourage everyone to get involved:

Year Group Challenge:

Children will compete against others in their year group.

Class Challenge:

The class that raises the most money through sponsorship will earn a special reward.

Individual Challenge:

The child who raises the most sponsorship money will also receive a special reward.

Most importantly, we want the children to have fun, challenge themselves and encourage one another while helping to improve the PE opportunities available to everyone at High View.

Please make your voluntary donation via **School Gateway by Monday 28th September**.

Sponsorship money can be donated via **School Gateway after the event**, once the children know how many laps they have completed.

All children should come to school wearing their PE kit on Friday 2nd October. Please ensure that they have suitable trainers for the event.

Thank you for your continued support. We hope that the children will enjoy '**Beat the Beep!**' and that, together, we can raise enough money to purchase some fantastic new gymnastics equipment for our school.
